



GCC - HOPE HOUSE VOLUNTEER TEAMS



COMFORT & CARE TEAM

The primary purpose of this team is to physically and spiritually prepare rooms for incoming guest families.

- **Serving Time:** Notice given to team leader approximately 10-14 days prior to new family arriving. This happens a couple of times a quarter.
- **Volunteers:** A team of 8-16 that could be called upon. Anyone under 16 must serve with a parent. Must complete online orientation and sign required liability waiver. Background check required.
- **Serving Focus:**
 - Clean & reset rooms that have been vacated
 - Touch up paint as necessary
 - Prepare welcome baskets and welcome blessing notes
 - Pray through the rooms
 - As team develops, new ideas are welcomed
 - If members of this team have organizational skills, Hope House would like to call request special project help in organizing pantries, storage room, etc.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES TEAM

The primary purpose of this team is to offer and organize activities outside for the children and adult residents. The Hope House sets on 4 acres and the school next door may be available for use.

- **Serving Time:** Team should offer at least two organized outdoor activities a month. Different team members can serve at different activities. More activities may be scheduled as the team develops and grows.
- **Volunteers:** Individuals or families may serve together. Must complete online orientation and sign required liability waiver. Background check required.
- **Serving Focus:**
 - Organize sports or playtimes
 - Organize bike rides
 - Organize outdoor activities away from House such as boat rides on lake with Hope House approval and appropriate waivers
 - Organize outdoor movie nights, times around the fire pit, use the outdoor stage, picnics, scavenger hunts, etc.
 - Go for walk and talk with Hope House parent
 - Other ideas are welcomed as the team develops

HOME MAINTENANCE & REPAIR TEAM

The primary purpose of this team is to help with inside and outside home maintenance to ensure the guest families are living in a safe and well maintained home.

- **Serving Time:** On call mostly. From time to time an identified project may be scheduled due to size and scope.
- **Volunteers:** Men or women with home repair skills. Must complete online-orientation and sign required liability waiver. Background check required if working inside or if serving multiple days outside.
- **Serving Focus:**
 - Inside home repairs of all types: plumbing, electrical, hardware, put up shelving, etc.
 - Outside home repairs as identified
 - Move donated furniture or items from storage to house or reverse
 - Special projects may be identified from time to time that go beyond a home repair. This team would be asked to join in
