## I Choose: Part 1



Life is a matter of \_\_\_\_\_ and every choice you make makes you.

Everything in your life is a reflection of a choice you have made. If you want a different result, make a different choice.

In life you can live for the approval of God or you can live for the approval of people, but you can't do both. We all must make a choice between purpose or popularity.

### Hebrews 11:24–26

Moses was an Israelite who was raised in the comfort of the Egyptian monarch's house. He grew up having the best of everything and was positioned as a prince. Yet, he chose to follow God's direction rather than live in the comfort of the palace.

### The Power of Purpose

3. Purpose pushes you through the \_\_\_\_\_. (Exodus 15:22–25)
  - The pathway to your purpose is paved with pain, but when you have clarity of purpose you keep going through the pain.
4. Purpose empowers you to \_\_\_\_\_ God. (Hebrews 11:26)
  - We can't please everyone, but we can please God.
